Dear parents & caregivers,

As part of our studies in religious education this term we have been learning all about the Jewish religion. We have looked at the history behind the Jewish stories in the Torah, learning about the exodus and the ten plagues in Egypt.

After the Easter holidays we will be looking at the modern practises of the religion including the festival of Pesach, the food laws of the religion and we will even be visiting a synagogue and Jewish Museum.

The trip will take place on the morning of **Friday 23rd April 2010**. (The first Friday back after Easter) We will travel by coach at 9.30 to the Manchester Jewish Museum which has its own non-working synagogue that we can have a look around and we will have a look at the artefacts in the museum on a guided tour. We will then travel back to school before lunch ready for Golden time! (What a great day for the children!)

The cost of this faith visit is £7.50 per child which includes entrance into the museum and deconsecrated synagogue as well as the guided tour and return travel to and from school. We will be travelling within school hours and returning before lunch. School uniform must be worn by the children on this day.
